## SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Norrie does ordain as follows:

- 1. TOWN ROADS AS SNOWMOBILE ROUTES. The operation of snowmobiles is hereby permitted on Town roads which contain signs indicating that such town road is open to snowmobile traffic. The Town grants said permission subject to the following terms and conditions and with the understanding that the Town will not be liable for any injury to person or property which arises from the use or operation of snowmobiles on any right of way of the Town of Norrie.
- 2. AUTOMOBILE TRAFFIC HAS RIGHT OF WAY. On marked snowmobile roads, snowmobiles shall operate only adjacent to the marked Town roads and whenever possible in the ditches maintained on the Town right of way, and shall conform to the flow of automobile traffic at all times.
- 3. HEAD LAMPS AND TAIL LAMPS. Any snowmobile operated during the hours of darkness, or operated during daylight hours on or in the vicinity of Town roads, shall display a lighted head lamp and tail lamp.
- 4. PENALTIES. Any person who violates any provision of this chapted may be fined not less than \$10 nor more than \$20 for the first offense and not less than \$25 nor more than \$50 for the second or subsequent offense within a year.
- 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication, upon the routes completely and appropriately marked.
