

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-5,
TOWN OF NORRIE, MARATHON, WISCONSIN, REGARDING
DISCONTINUANCE OF PORTIONS OF CARY STREET,
ANSON STREET AND DERHAM STREET**

WHEREAS, portions of the public rights-of-way known as Cary Street, Anson Street and Derham Street in the Town of Norrie, Marathon County, Wisconsin, has neither a present nor future use as public rights-of-way and it is in the public's interest to vacate and discontinue the same. Said portions of the public rights-of-way are legally described as follows:

ANSON STREET VACATION:

Of part of the Map of Village of Norrie, in Volume 2 of plats on Page 4, located in part of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, part of Government Lot 1 and part of Government Lot 2, Section 23, Township 28 North, Range 10 East, Town of Norrie, Marathon County, Wisconsin described as follows:

That portion of Anson Street lying between the East right-of-way line of Bradley Street and the West right-of-way line of County Road "D".

CARY STREET VACATION:

Of part of the Map of Village of Norrie, in Volume 2 of plats on Page 4, located in part of Government Lot 2, Section 23, Township 28 North, Range 10 East, Town of Norrie, Marathon County, Wisconsin described as follows:

That portion of Cary Street lying between the South right-of-way line of Anson Street and the North right-of-way line of Beekman Street.

DERHAM STREET VACATION:

Of part of the Map of Village of Norrie, in Volume 2 of plats on Page 4, located in part of Government Lot 2, Section 23, Township 28 North, Range 10 East, Town of Norrie, Marathon County, Wisconsin described as follows:

That portion of Derham Street lying between the South right-of-way line of Anson Street and the North right-of-way line of Beekman Street.

A map depicting and highlighting the portions of the public rights-of-way to be discontinued and vacated is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 66.1003(4) allows proceedings to be initiated by the Town Board by the introduction of a Resolution declaring that, since the public interest requires it, the whole or any part of any public way, road, street or alley in the Town may be vacated pursuant to the procedures therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Town of Norrie has no present nor future interest in the portions of the public rights-of-way described hereinabove; the discontinuance of the portions of the public rights-of-way shall not result in land locked parcels; the discontinuance will not deprive a landowner or a public school of all access to a highway; and the public interest requires that such portions of said public rights-of-way be vacated and discontinued pursuant to the provisions of Wis. Stat. § 66.1003.

2. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1005(2)(a), the Town of Norrie shall release any of its easement rights, if any, in the portions of the public rights-of-way being vacated.

3. A public hearing on the passage of this Resolution will be held on the 13th day of July, 2026, at the Norrie Town Hall, located at 183453 Cornell Street, Birnamwood, Wisconsin 54414, commencing at 6:45 p.m. on said date, which hearing is not less than forty (40) days after the date on which this Resolution was introduced.

4. The Town Clerk shall cause a notice of said public hearing stating when and where this Resolution shall be acted upon to be published as a Class 3 notice under Wis. Stat. Ch. 985 and shall further arrange for said notice to be served personally on all of the owners of all of the frontage of the lots and lands abutting upon the portions of the public rights-of-way sought to be discontinued if said service can be made within the Town; otherwise, copies of said notice shall be mailed to the owner's last known address at least thirty (30) days before the hearing. If any of the public ways are located within one-quarter mile of a state trunk highway or connecting highway, a copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the Secretary of Transportation and the Commissioner of Railroads if there is a railroad highway crossing within the public rights-of-way to be discontinued pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 66.1003(8)(a).

5. The matter shall be referred to the Town Plan Commission for its consideration and report before final action by the Town Board.


6. The Town Clerk shall properly post or publish this Resolution as required by law.
