1.0 Call to Order \& Roll Call- Called to order at $6: 35 \mathrm{pm}$. Present:

- Deposits on Fireworks and Portable Restrooms have been made.
- A $\$ 750$ donation from the Hales Corners Lion Club was received and will be reflected in the next financial report.

- Discussed location of food trucks and it was decided to locate food trucks in the pool parking lot along the south walkway. 90 feet or 16 parking stalls are needed. This area will be cordoned off. Food Trucks have the option to set up before 6 am or after 9:45am.

Set up time of noon was discussed and selling times will be finalized at the next meeting. The committee would like to set up tables and chairs to create a beer garden area. The committee will look into using some of the tables and chairs currently stored in the pool house.

- Since vendor for had already ordered supplies to make the $1^{\text {st }}$ place bed race trophies, the committee decided to purchase trophies which have no date and keep on hand for future race.
- The Hot Dog Eating Contest will replace bed race. 1pm HCE Janesville parking lot. The contest will be structured as the following weight classes: under $100 \mathrm{lbs} ., 100-200 \mathrm{lbs}$. and 200+lbs.
