-  Keep all medication out of reach of children. Even if your child might be older, you still need to secure medications
-  Lock your medicine cabinet or keep all medication in a secure location.
-  Don't tell many people about your medication types.
-  Know how much medication you have. If you suspect your medications are missing it is important to speak to your children.
-  Dispose of unused or outdated medication promptly and safely, as outlined above.
-  Be aware that prescription drug abuse can be the gateway to using illegal drugs.
