Property Tax Reminder

The second installment for property tax payments is due on or before **April 30th**. Reminders are not mailed. Payments received after a 7 day grace period are delinquent. Interest and penalty will accrue on unpaid balances retroactive to February 1st. Once delinquent, the total amount is due and the installment option is revoked. If you are paying by mail, reference your parcel number and a phone number on your check. Do not include your tax bill unless you also enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope for return to receive a printed receipt. Spring Election: April 4, 2023

Polling hours are 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at Village Hall. All registered voters will be required to provide photo ID to receive a ballot. Please have your photo ID out and ready for election officials. If you are not registered, you may do so ahead of time online at www.myvote.wi.gov or by submitting a voter registration form to the Village Hall. Twenty (20) days before each election voter registrations must be in person at Village Hall. In order to register, you will need valid proof of residence at your current address and have resided there for 28 consecutive days prior to the election. Early absentee voting will be held Tuesday, March 21st -Thursday March, 30th, 10:00 a.m.- 4:30 p.m. and Friday March 31st from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. You will be required to provide photo ID for absentee voting. All registered voters are able to vote early at Village Hall during this time. If you wish to receive your ballot by mail, you will need to submit an Absentee Ballot Application online at www.myvote.wi.gov or by mail to Village Hall with a copy of your photo ID. Summer Recreation Program

The Hales Corners Summer Recreation Program offers a variety of activities and optional field trips for children between the ages of 5 and 13. Activities vary from week to week and include arts and crafts, sports and games, playground time, and more. The program will take place Monday, June 12th through Friday, July 28th from 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. at the Hales Corners Elementary School.

Registration will begin Monday, April 10th. Watch the Village website for release of the program flyer and registration form. Payments must be made in full at the time of registration including field trips. The resident fee only applies to families with a Hales Corners property address. It does NOT apply to all families in the Whitnall School District as the program is funded by Hales Corners property tax dollars.

If you mail payment for an incorrect amount, your spot will NOT be held and you risk losing a spot in the program until the entire fee is received. When the program is full, it is full. There will not be a waiting list. Max capacity of the program is 150 participants. The last day to register will be Friday, May 5th. Keep in mind, it is common for the summer program to fill up well before the due date. Therefore, waiting until the deadline to register and pay is not recommended.

Pet Licensing

MADACC mailed renewal notices for 2023 dog & cat licensing in December. Pet owners may renew or license a new dog or cat at the Village Hall during normal business hours. Pet licenses are to be renewed each year at a cost of \$12 per pet for altered animals and \$24 for unaltered animals. The deadline to renew your pet license is **March 31st**. After this date a \$6 late fee will apply. This late fee does not apply to new pets to your household after the March 31st deadline. Proof of current rabies vaccination dates and tag number are required for new and renewal licensing.

Sump Pumps

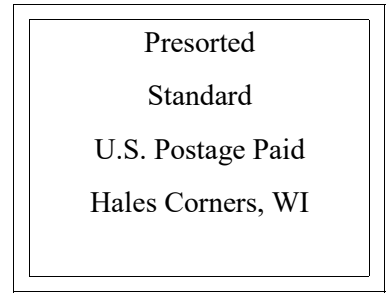
With Spring comes warmer weather, melting snow, ponding water, and drainage issues. These are all a reminder that the proper discharge of your sump pump means a drier basement for you AND your neighbors. Unless a ditch or storm sewer is nearby, it is recommended that a sump pump discharge no more than ten feet from your home and into your yard, NOT directed at a neighbor.

Sump pumps should never discharge into a stationary tub or basement floor drain. The extra water will cause the sanitary sewer system to overflow resulting in basement backups for you and/ or a neighbor.
