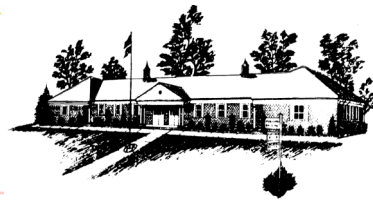

Property Tax Reminder

Your final installment is due on Monday, **July 31, 2023**. Payments made after the grace period ending August 7th at 5 p.m. will need to be sent and paid to the Milwaukee County Treasurers Office. For a copy of your tax bill or outstanding balance you can visit halescorners.org

Summer Yard Waste

During the summer months GFL Environmental only picks up yard waste once per month. Please see the GFL Environmental Pick Up Schedule that was sent out at the beginning of the year for pick up dates.



Copies of the schedule are available at Village Hall or on our website, halescorners.org. To ensure your yard waste is not left behind, make sure you are completing the following requirements. Place at curb by 6 a.m. Branches must be tied in bundles not to exceed one foot in diameter and four feet in length. All other yard waste must be put in paper bags, boxes, or trash containers. Plastic bags will **NOT** be accepted during the summer months. Weight cannot exceed **80 pounds**. If the above instructions are not followed, it will result in your yard waste remaining at your property.

Property Reminders

Households are allowed up to 2 rummage sales per calendar year. Signs may not be placed in the right-of-way. A max of four vehicles including recreational (boats, campers, trailers, etc.) are allowed to be kept on residential property and must be kept on an improved surface. Grass cannot exceed 12 inches in length.

FAQs

Will I be able to get to my home?
During construction you will be able to get to and from your home. There will be **NO PARKING** on the street during the construction. Please use caution when driving on the roadway as it will be very rough and there will be manholes and valves that will be sticking up.

Will Village Hall be open during construction?

There will be access to the Village Hall to conduct business during normal hours.

Will garbage or mail service be interrupted?

Mail and garbage/recycling service should not be interrupted.

DPW Reminders

Watch for noxious weeds and invasive species on your property such as Canada thistle, leafy spurge, and bindweed. If you have questions in regards to this, you may pick up a brochure at the Village Hall or Public Library and you may also call UW-Extension Office at 414-291-2400.

Be mindful of where your sump pump discharge is going and who it may be affecting. It should not be flowing onto or across a public street, right of way or sidewalk or your adjacent neighbors' lot.
