FIELD TRIP TRANSPORTATION

Buses leave 30 minutes prior to start time and return approximately 30 minutes after the field trip concludes. Parent drop off or pick up is not allowed.

Children can bring their own lunch. Water, Gatorade, soda, pizza by the slice, Corn Dogs, chicken nuggets, and a variety of snacks are available for purchase.
