Property Tax Reminder

The final installment for property tax payments are due on Wednesday, July 31st, 2024. Payments made after the grace period ending August 7th at 4 p.m. will need to be sent and paid to the Milwaukee County Treasurer's Office. Summer Yard Waste

During the summer months, Environmental only picks up yard waste once per month. Please see the GFL Environmental Pick Up Schedule that was sent out at the beginning of the year for pick up dates. As you may have already noticed, the Yard Waste Pickup info on the back of the schedule that was mailed at the beginning of the year is outdated. New/updated copies of the info sheet with the schedule are available at Village Hall or on our website, halescornerswi.gov. To ensure your yard waste is not left behind, make sure you are completing the following requirements. Place at curb by 6 a.m. Branches must be tied in bundles not to exceed one foot in diameter and four feet in length. All other yard waste must be put in paper bags, boxes, or trash containers. New requirements include only 6 bags/bundles/containers will be allowed per household to be picked up. Plastic bags will **NOT** be accepted during the summer months. Weight cannot exceed 50 pounds. If these instructions are not followed, it will result in your yard waste remaining at your property. Please note, 10 bags/bundles/containers will be allowed for the last 5 pick ups of the year.

Have extra vard waste? GFL has a yard drop off site available waste Hales Corners residents for free. There is no limit to the amount of yard waste you can bring. The site is located at: W144S6350 College Court, Muskego, WI 53150 and is open Saturdays 7am-2pm. Proof of residency is required.
