

General Election: November 5, 2024

Polling hours are 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. at Village Hall. All registered voters will be required to provide photo ID to receive a ballot. Please have your photo ID out and ready for election officials. If you are not registered, you may do so ahead of time online at www.myvote.wi.gov or by submitting a voter registration form to the Village Hall. Twenty (20) days before each election, voter registrations must be in person at Village Hall. In order to register you will need valid proof of residence at your current address and have resided there for 28 consecutive days prior to the election. Early absentee voting will be held Tuesday, October 22nd through Thursday October, 31st, 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Friday, November 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. You will be required to provide photo ID for absentee voting. All registered voters are able to vote early at Village Hall during this time. If you wish to receive your ballot by mail you will need to submit an Absentee Ballot Application online at www.myvote.wi.gov or by mail to Village Hall with a copy of your photo ID. For questions, call the Village Hall Administration Offices at 414-529-6161.

Please Note: Village Hall will NOT have a drop box available for absentee ballots. All absentee ballots must be returned by mail or turned in to the clerk's office in person during office hours by the voter.

Permits/Inspections

You may not schedule an appointment for an inspection until your permit application has been issued and fees have been paid. A final inspection is always required to close a permit.
