E-WASTE DISPOSAL

What is E-Waste?

Electronic waste, or e-waste, is electrical and electronic equipment that's no longer being of use. It includes a range of items (Listed Below). These are items that should not be discarded within the regular garbage (refuse). These items contain lead and other hazardous materials within them. If such materials are released into the environment, it will contaminate our waterways, ground water and soils.

The Village of Hales Corners has partnered with COM2, a company that processes electronic waste. This company is regulated by the Wis-DNR. The Village has a location for unused electric items to be safely collected and to be received for recycling by COM2.

Where is this location at?

The drop box is located behind Village Hall.

What happens after the waste gets dropped off?

Once received by COM2, items with data, like laptops, have their memory erased and are reused if possible. Those that cannot be repurposed are processed into materials which are used to create ceramic tiles.

Item; COM2 accept;....

Computers, laptops, tablets, & iPads fax machines, stereos, calculators, cameras, copiers, game consoles, telephones, handheld electronics, scanners, toasters, monitors, TVs, DVD Players, & VCRs, camcorders, shredders, printers, electric motors, modems, answering machines microwaves, cellphones, vacuums, inverters, solar panels.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED.....

Refrigerators, Stoves, washers, dryers, and other 'white goods', coffee makers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, smoke detectors, batteries, fans, blenders, fluorescent light bulbs

How much does this service cost?

This service is totally free to Village residents.
