

PROJECT OVERVIEW

I-41/43/894 Airport Freeway/Hale Interchange Resurfacing Project to Begin

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is scheduled to begin a resurfacing project along I-894/I-41/I-43 through the Hale Interchange in Milwaukee County. This project is part of ongoing efforts to enhance safety and extend pavement life. Work is scheduled to begin the week of May 27 and is expected to be completed in late 2026.

WORK TO BE COMPLETED:

- Concrete base patching
- Resurfacing approximately 3.5 miles along 1-41/43/894
- Bridge improvements on 17 structures within the Hale Interchange
- Pavement repairs in the Hales Corners Park & Ride lot
- High friction surface treatments
- Guardrail replacement
- Curb ramp replacement
- Signal and lighting improvements

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

- Long-term system ramp closures
- Long-term local road lane closures
- Extended weekend, full freeway, and system ramp clsoures
- Overnight full freeway, lane and ramp closures



Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
