Weekend Full Freeway Closures

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing with the rehabilitation of I-894 between 84th and 35th streets in Milwaukee County. The following work is scheduled as part of this project.

Beginning Friday, June 6 at 11 P.M. through Monday, June 9 by 5:30 A.M.:

Westbound I-894 is scheduled to fully close from the Mitchell Interchange to the Hale Interchange for final paving operations.

 Eastbound lanes will remain OPEN during the westbound closure.

Note: The I-894 westbound exit ramp to northbound Loomis Road will be closed starting on Thursday, June 5 at 9 p.m. for equipment mobilization.

Beginning Friday, June 13 at 11 P.M. through Monday, June 16 by 5:30 A.M.:

Eastbound I-894 is scheduled to fully close from the Hale Interchange to the Mitchell Interchange for final paving operations.

 Westbound lanes will remain OPEN during the eastbound closure.

Note: The I-894 eastbound exit ramp to Loomis Road will be closed starting on Thursday, June 12 at 9 p.m. for equipment mobilization.

Regional Alternate Route:

Motorists are encouraged to use I-41, I-43 and I-94 to get around the closures.



Please note all work is weather dependent and subject to change.



Contingency Dates

In the event of inclement weather, the closure of I-894 westbound will be rescheduled to June 13-16, and the closure of I-894 eastbound will be rescheduled for July 18-21.
