The final installment for property tax payments are due on Thursday, **July 31st, 2025**. Payments made after the grace period ending August 7th at 4 p.m. will need to be sent and paid to the Milwaukee County Treasurer's Office. Visit our website before starting your renovation project to find out if a permit is needed and to plan your project timeline accordingly. You will also find regulations on fences, sheds, garages, pools, and other accessory structures. Permits are also required for working in the right of way for new driveways and culverts. Fees may be doubled if work begins prior to the issuance of the permit.



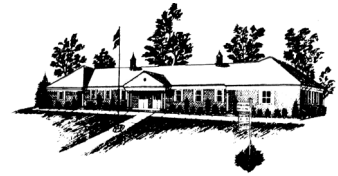
Library Renovations

Election News

If you have moved locations within the Village, including apartments within the same complex, the law requires you to re-register in order to vote. To register, you will need valid proof of residence at your current address and have resided there for 28 consecutive days. You can apply at www.myvote.wi.gov, mail in an application with proof of ID and residence, or in person during normal business hours at Village Hall. For a list of acceptable documents, please contact Village Hall.

Indefinitely confined voters must return ballots for each April and November election in order to continue to get ballots by mail. If you did not return a ballot this past election, you have been removed from the list. You will need to resubmit a request for future elections. To do so, complete an Absentee Ballot Application online either at www.myvote.wi.gov or mail a request to Village Hall.
