1st Story Time at the Library 1978

Since 1975, the Hales Corners Public Library has been a cherished part of the village—built from a dream and powered by a community that believed in the importance of access, learning, and connection. What began as a modest collection in the Village Hall became a reality with the library's first official building in 1985.

In 1995, the card catalog gave way to the County Catalog (CoCat), bringing digital searches to our fingertips. Internet access arrived in 1996, and by 2004, the library offered wireless internet and online materials.

Today, we continue to grow. In 2024, our circulation reached nearly 90,000 items, with digital checkouts up 19% from 2023. Over 5,700 children attended library programs, and our annual Trunk 'N' Treat brought 200+ families together for fall fun.

As we look toward the future, our new 2025–2028 Strategic Plan: Connected Communities lays the groundwork for exciting enhancements, like makerspaces, expanded technology, and flexible spaces to meet the changing needs of our patrons.
