Overview

The WIS 24 project will improve approximately 5 miles of roadway. Improvements include:

- Resurface WIS 24 within project limits
- Replace traffic signals/lighting at various locations
- Improvements to bridge structure at 76th Street
- · Improvements to sidewalks and curb ramps

Traffic Impacts during Construction

- WIS 24 will be reduced to one lane in each direction
- Parking lane restrictions in active construction zones
- Overnight or short-term closures on various ramps and intersections. Alternate sideroad access will be provided
- Temporary pedestrian detour will be signed
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction

Project Update

- 45th Street to Howard Avenue (segment 1) Substantially Complete November 2025
- Howard Avenue to Janesville Road (segment 2)
 Lane closures with some carry over work in
 Spring 2026, weather dependent

Winter Shutdown: Mid-December, weather dependent

Opening all lanes to original traffic patterns,
 2 lanes in each direction
