## Spring Election: April 7, 2026

Polling hours are 7 am - 8 pm at Village Hall. All registered voters will be required to provide photo ID to receive a ballot. If you are not registered, you may do so ahead of time online at [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov). In order to register, you will need valid proof of residence at your current address and have resided there for 28 consecutive days prior to the election. Early absentee voting will be held weekdays Tuesday, March 24th -Thursday, April 2nd, 9:30 a.m.– 3:30 p.m. and Friday, April 3rd from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. You will be required to provide photo ID for in person absentee voting. All registered voters are able to vote early at Village Hall during this time. If you wish to receive your ballot by mail, you will need to submit an Absentee Ballot Application online at [www.myvote.wi.gov](http://www.myvote.wi.gov) or by mail to Village Hall with a copy of your photo ID. ### Property Tax Reminder

The second installment property tax payment is due **Thursday, April 30th**. Payment reminders are not mailed. After a 7 day grace period unpaid properties will be delinquent. Interest and penalty will accrue on unpaid balances retroactive to February 1st. Once delinquent, the total amount of the tax bill is due and installment option is revoked. If you are paying by mail, reference your parcel number and a phone number on your check. Do not include your original tax bill unless you also enclose a self-addressed postage stamped envelope for return. ### Code Enforcement Tips

Tips to avoid common code enforcement violations:  
Long grass/weeds - grass must not be over 12 inches in height.  
Garbage/Recycling - Place receptacles at the curb no more than 24 hours prior to pick up and remove no later than 24 hours after pick up. The same applies to yard waste.  
Rubbish, inoperable vehicles, salvage material, or misc refuse may be stored on a residential property.  
Vehicles - No more than 4 vehicles shall be stored on a property at any time including recreational vehicles. Vehicles must be parked on a improved surface.

### Rummage Sales & Signs

Residents are allowed three rummage sales per calendar year not to exceed 72 consecutive hours within any one week.  
Rummage sales, garage sales, estate sales, or other sale signs shall only be placed on private property with owners consent. Rummage sale signs are exempt from permit fees. State and local laws prohibit these signs in the public right-of-way or public locations. Signs placed in the right-of-way will be removed.

### Pet Licensing

MADACC mailed renewal notices for 2026 dog & cat licensing in December. Pet owners may renew or license a new dog/cat at Village Hall or online at [madacc.org](http://madacc.org). Pet licenses are to be renewed each year at a cost of \$12 per pet for altered animals and \$24 for unaltered animals. The deadline to renew your pet license is **March 31st**. After this date a \$6 late fee will apply. This late fee does not apply to pets new to your household after the March 31st deadline. Proof of current rabies vaccination dates and rabies tag number are required for new **and** renewal licensing.



### Summer Recreation Program

The Hales Corners Summer Recreation Program offers a variety of activities and optional field trips for children between the ages of 5 and 13. Activities vary from week to week and include arts and crafts, sports and games, playground time, and more.

Registration will begin Monday, April 13th. Watch the Village website for release of the program flyer and registration form. Payments must be made in full at the time of registration including field trips. The resident fee only applies to families residing in Hales Corners. It does NOT apply to all families in the Whitnall School District as the program is funded by Hales Corners tax dollars.

Max capacity of the program is 150 participants. The last day to register will be Friday, May 8th. Keep in mind, it is common for the summer program to fill up well before the registration close date.


### Sump Pumps

Sewer systems are designed to handle wastewater from inside your home such as toilets, sinks, and showers. They're not meant to accommodate the large volumes of groundwater that sump pumps move. During heavy rain, sump pumps are designed to quickly move water away from your home's foundation which can add a significant load to the municipal sewer system if discharged improperly. Excess water can force sewage backups in your drains, creating an unsanitary and costly mess. Overflowing sewers can cause wastewater to back up into nearby homes and streets, spreading contamination and increasing cleanup costs for everyone. Overloading the sewer system during a storm can also have devastating effects on the environment. When wastewater facilities become overwhelmed, they may discharge untreated or partially treated sewage into nearby rivers, lakes, or streams. This pollution can harm aquatic ecosystems, contaminate drinking water sources, and create long-term environmental damage.
