


### **Annual Net Valuation Taxable**







## Analysis of 2021 Budget Revenues








## Analysis of 2021 Budget Appropriations - \$7,788,333.30











Net Debt as a Percentage of 3-Year Average Equalized Valuation







# 2020 Ranking in Monmouth County
