NOTICE OF CONSERVATION EASEMENT RESTRICTIONS


The parcel of land that you have purchased contains a conservation easement that restricts some of your use of that portion of the property. During review of the site plans for this development and/or permit it was determined by the reviewing agencies that part of your land contains unique environmental characteristics that may contain one or more of the following: streams, wetlands, watercourses, tree preservation, unusual topography (steep slopes, hills, etc.), rare or endangered species or habitat of the same, and other related features.

By acceptance of conveyance of this land to you, you are PROHIBITED from: altering stream courses; constructing dams or other obstructions to stream flow; filling in depressions, ponds, wetlands, marshes, and other aquatic features; excavating hills, filling vegetation; disposing of trash, oils pesticides, chemicals, or other noxious materials; clearing vegetation and trees; constructing structures of any kind, whether permanent or temporary; making any changes to the existing environment within the easement.


Any changes you make to the environment within the conservation easement may subject you to fines or other penalties under the law. While the forces of nature are constantly changing, your alterations of lands within the conservation easement may hasten some natural processes (such erosion), which may in turn cause destruction to your property or that of your neighbors for which may in turn cause destruction to your property or that of your neighbors for which you will be solely responsible.
