RESOLUTION NO. 25.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WENDELL, IDAHO CHANGING THE PROCEDURE FOR APPROVING THE CITY'S REGULAR PAYROLL.

WHEREAS, The City of Wendell requires that the payroll for the City employees be approved at a regular scheduled City Council meeting before the employees can receive their payroll checks, and

WHEREAS, There has been occassions where the City Council was unable to do any business because of a lack of a quorum due to illness and/or other committments of council members, and

WHEREAS, If a quorum is not available to approve the payrol!, a special council meeting must be called to do so, and

WHEREAS, The City of Wendell desires to eliminate the need to call a special council meeting to approve the regular payroll.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The City of Wendell's regular payroll will no longer have to be approved by the City Council before payroll checks can be issued to the City employees.
