ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE to prohibit all parking by motor vehicles on the west side of Bridge Street and the South side of Main Street in the Town of Mardela Springs, Maryland and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Mardela Springs, that it shall be unlawful for any motor vehicle to park or remain unattended on the West side of Bridge Street and the South side of Main Street where the curb is depressed along the parking lot of the United States Post Office in the Town of Mardela Springs.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Mardela Springs, that signs marked with the words "No Parking at Any Time" or signs with similar wording shall be erected on the West side of Bridge Street and the South side of Main Street as set forth in Section 1 hereof in said Town which said signs shall be clearly visible to the operator of motor vehicles using said streets.

SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED, that the signs to be erected pursuant to Section 2 hereof, shall conform to the State Manual and Specifications as established by the Department of Transportation of the State of Maryland or by the Department of Transportation of the United States.

SECTION 4: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Mardela Springs, that any operator or owner of said motor vehicles violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a "municipal infraction" as provided in Section 3 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1980 Cumulative Supplement) and a fine assessed as therein provided.

SECTION 5: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Mardela Springs that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its final passage.

The above Ordinance was introduced and read at a meeting of the Commissioners of Mardela Springs held on the 14th day of January, 1981 and after notice of a public hearing thereon was duly posted in five public
