ORDINANCE NO. 48 49

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT CHAPTER 200 OF THE WICOMICO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO SUBDIVISION OF LAND AND TO PERMIT EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS OF WICOMICO COUNTY TO ENFORCE ITS PROVISIONS WITHIN THE TOWN OF MARDELA SPRINGS.

WHEREAS Wicomico County has offered to enforce the provisions of its code relating to subdivision of land within the boundaries of the Town if the Town adopts that section of the County Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF MARDELA SPRINGS, as follows:

SECTION ONE – That Chapter 200, inclusive, of the Wicomico County Code, as amended from time to time, be and hereby is adopted by the Commissioners of Mardela Springs.

SECTION TWO – That Wicomico County, its agents and employees, be and hereby are authorized to enforce the provisions of Chapter 200 of the Wicomico County Code within the Town of Mardela Springs in the same manner and with the same authority as they would in Wicomico County.

SECTION THREE – That any and all provisions of the current laws and ordinances of the Town of Mardela Springs which in any way conflict with or could in any way be interpreted in a manner inconsistent with Chapter 200 of Wicomico County Code be and hereby are declared void and repealed.

SECTION FOUR - That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its final passage.

This Ordinance having been read and passed on first reading on the ight day of law and a second reading and public hearing having been held it was finally passed on the 16th day of reading. 2010.
