A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FREEDOM TRAFFIC MAP

WHEREAS, a 10 (ten) mile per hour speed limit sign was erected on the Northwest side of South Linn Street under the prior administration's request and not under the direction of the full Board. South Linn Street is the Village Park entrance and exit road and the miles per hour speed limit inside the park premises is 10 (ten) miles per hour.

THEREFORE, The Village of North Freedom Board hereby resolves to amend Village of North Freedom Ordinance 7.02, Traffic Map, to indicate that the speed limit on ONLY South Linn Street shall be 10 (ten) miles per hour, leaving all other *Village* roads in the Village limits 25 (twenty-five) miles per hour and the alleyways 15 (fifteen) miles per hour, unless otherwise specified.
