

Freedom Days 2025 Event Map

Friday 6/27 – Sunday 6/29

E Walnut to N/S Linn Street



From the corner of 100 E Walnut Street to 212 E Walnut Street, also encompassing 100 S Oak Street to approximately 110 S Oak Street, there will be barricades (**yellow lines on map**) blocking off the road for public safety. These barricades also serve as the perimeter for open intoxicants. There shall be no open intoxicants beyond the barricades – *N Oak Street during the Car Show is an exception* *. Adults needing fermented malt beverages for the entertainment can purchase them from either BS Depot or Old Freedom House. **THERE WILL BE NO PARKING IN THIS VICINITY STARTING MONDAY, JUNE 23, 2025 – 12:00 AM AND GOING THROUGH MONDAY, JUNE 30, 2025 – 12:00 PM. **** There will be a fire lane through the middle that will be available for Emergency Services and porta-potties available for the public.

Located in the E Walnut Street barricaded area will be food vendors, a carnival, live music starting on Friday, June 27, 2025 at 5:00 PM.

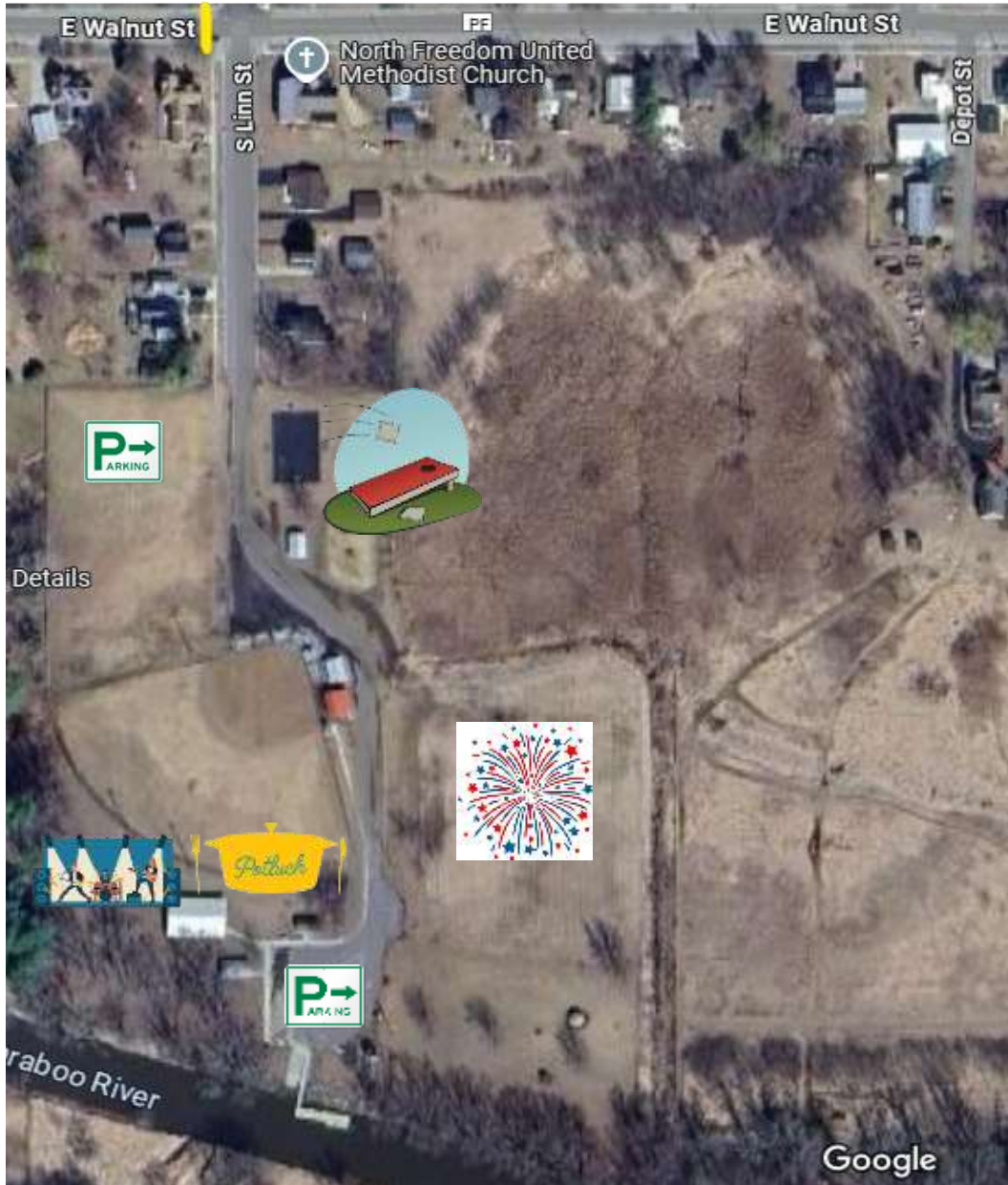
On N Oak Street, Saturday, June 28, 2025 there will be a car show 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM. **THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ON N OAK STREET STARTING SATURDAY, JUNE 28, 2025 AT 12:00 AM AND GOING UNTIL 6:00 PM. **** Entries for the car show need to speak with BS Depot on how to enter and will be allowed to drive through “Firetruck Alley” to park for the show.

On S Oak Street, Saturday, June 28, 2025 & Sunday, June 29, 2025 there will be a craft/vendor/farmer’s market 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM/11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. **THERE WILL BE NO PARKING ON S OAK STREET FROM 100 S OAK ST TO APPROXIMATELY 110 S OAK STREET STARTING SATURDAY, JUNE 28, 2025 AT 12:00 AM AND GOING UNTIL SUNDAY, JUNE 29, 2025 AT 5:00 PM. ****

Village Park



In the Village Park on Saturday, June 28, 2025, there will be a bean bag tournament that starts at 1:00 PM on the basketball court. Entry fee for an adult doubles team is **\$30.00**. 1/3 of the entry fee will go towards Freedom Days and the remainder will be divided out for prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. There will be other sets for children to participate, but there will be no actual tournament for kids.

There will be a fireworks presentation that is put on by the Emery Family starting at dusk. They also are having live music down in the Large Shelter (closest to the boat launch) in the park from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

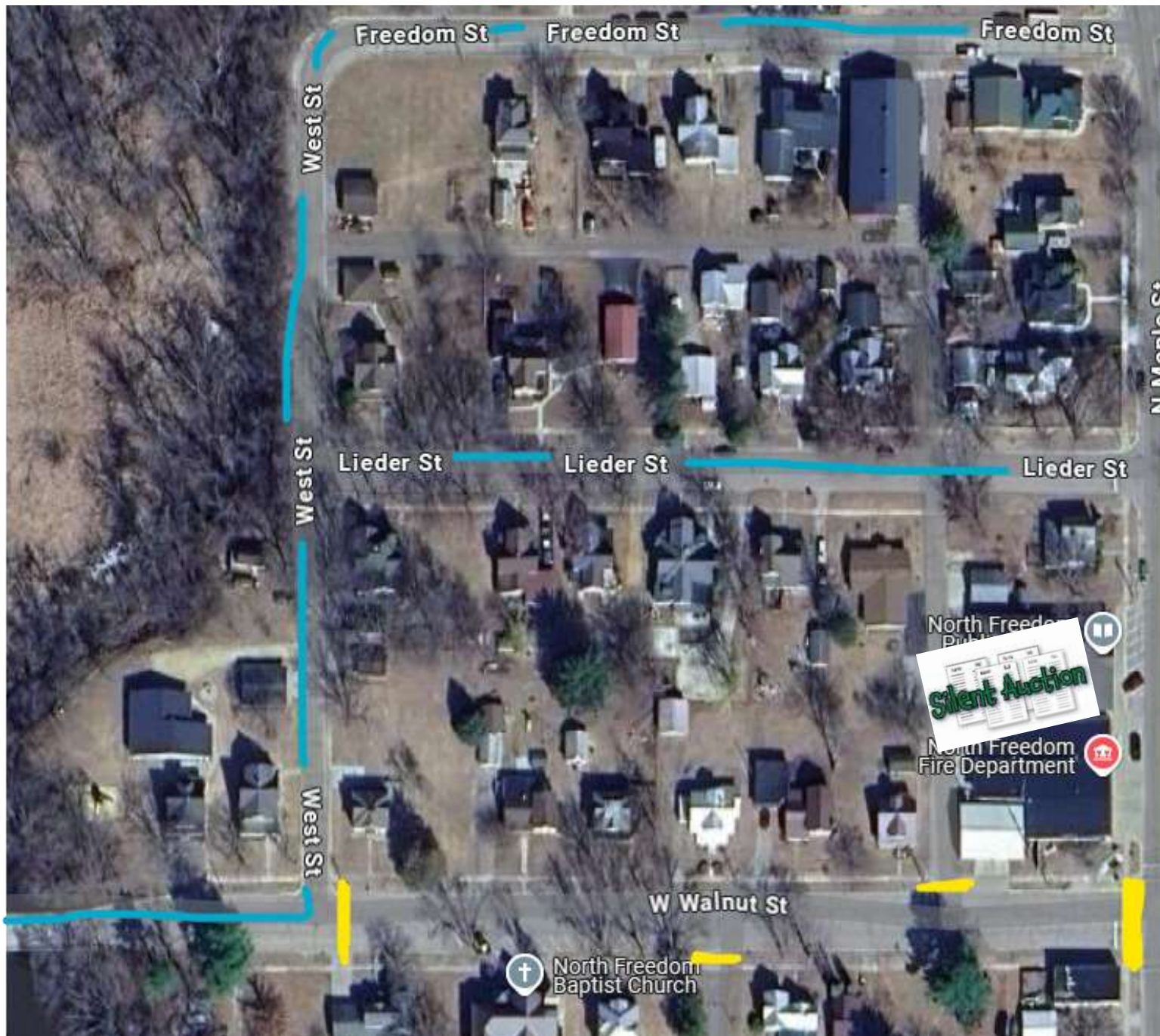

Due to congestion and the majority of the grass areas being in DNR protected wetlands, **THERE WILL BE NO AVAILABLE PARKING EXCEPT IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING LOT BELOW BY THE BOAT LAUNCH OR IF IT IS NOT TOO WET, IN THE NORTHWESTERN FIELD! IF THE FIELD AREA IS WET, IT WILL BE ROPED OFF FOR NO PARKING.****

THERE WILL ALSO BE NO PARKING ON W WALNUT STREET FROM THE “4 CORNERS” TO WEST STREET STARTING ON SUNDAY, JUNE 29, 2025 AT 11:00 AM UNTIL 5:00 PM** for the Mini Tractor Pullers Association Tractor Pull Event.** The detour would be to take either Freedom or Lieder Street to West Street.

In the North Freedom Community Center, there will be a Silent Auction going on starting Friday, June 27, 2025 6:00 PM – get your bids in! Bidding closes and the winners will then have until 5:00 PM on Sunday, June 29 to pick up their winnings. There will also availability for a cooling shelter or mother’s room for the public to use.
