Located in the E Walnut Street barricaded area will be food vendors, a carnival, live music starting on Friday, June 27, 2025 at 5:00 PM.



In the Village Park on Saturday, June 28, 2025, there will be a bean bag tournament that starts at 1:00 PM on the basketball court. 
