Tax Collection Information

The Village of North Freedom Village Office (105 N Maple St, North Freedom, WI 53951) will be collecting tax payments during the normal posted Office Hours, however *Mailed payments are appreciated* and can be sent to "Village of North Freedom – ATTN: Clerk/Treasurer – PO Box 300, North Freedom, WI 53951" – and you may also use our convenient drop box service located directly underneath the window with the Office Hours of the Village Clerk! We also have an online payment option!

<u>Dog Licenses - *Send a separate check for</u> <u>dog licenses!*</u>

Dogs 5 months of age or older are required to be registered by <u>April 1</u> of each year. Information needed for dog tags: Dog Name, Color, Breed, Sex, Vaccine/Vaccine Manufacturer Serial #, Vet Proof of Rabies Vaccination, Date Given & Expiration Date. Village residents are limited to only <u>2</u> dogs per household with the exception to exceed the limit to 3 dogs per household with application prior to getting 3rd dog – Village Ordinance 12.08(13).

Neutered Male/Female: \$7.00
Duplicate License: \$6.00
Late Fee: \$10.00
3rd Dog Application Fee: \$25.00

Friends and Neighbors,

Season's greetings. Hope your holidays have been all you wished for.

As we enter 2026 there are just a few issues I want to bring to your attention:

First, please review the materials presented regarding a referendum coming up on the April ballot. Oak Hill Cemetery Association, located in the village, needs restructuring. As of now the Cemetery Board is a separate entity and may need to be absorbed by the village. Nicki has prepared some excellent materials explaining the position as it stands. Please check it out and/or attend the public information meeting on Jan. 12 at 6 PM in the village hall.

Then at **6:30 PM** that same evening, the **village caucus** will be held. There are three trustee seats up for bid in the April election. If you have ever considered running for office, I earnestly invite you to attend the caucus. Nominees need a first and a second nomination to get their names on the ballot, so be sure you have two people to nominate you. Any eligible voter in the village may run for office or nominate candidates.

I see nothing but great potential for the new Friends of the Village of North Freedom group that formed in 2025. Many great ideas have been discussed by the group. What is needed though is YOU. Join the Friends and help the village grow and prosper. Next meeting is **Jan. 19** at **6 PM** in the Village Hall. Contact the village for more information.

Lastly, one long range project I'd like to make you aware of is that Sauk County Highway Department plans to rebuild the Co. PF bridge over the Baraboo River in the summer of 2027. Currently the village's sanitary sewer pipes for the houses south of the river are located on/under the bridge structure. This will not be allowed on the new bridge so the village will be dropping those pipes below the river to connect with the north pipes. This must be done well in advance of the county doing their work and is scheduled for the Summer/Fall of 2026. This project should not require any closure of the bridge during its completion. However, when the county gets to work in 2027 the bridge will be closed, possibly for the entire summer and/or into the fall.

Wishing each and every one of you a healthy, prosperous 2026. May it bring peace and happiness to all.

Snow and Ice Removal Reminders

Per Village Ordinance 8.04 - the owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every building or structure or unoccupied lot in the village fronting or abutting any street shall clean, or cause to be cleaned, the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such building or unoccupied lot of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within 24 hours after the cessation of a snowstorm. When the ice has formed on any sidewalk so that it cannot be immediately removed, the persons herein referred to shall keep the same sprinkled with salt, ashes, sawdust or sand. No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, any snow or ice taken and removed from his premises or elsewhere upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public place or street in the Village. CEMETERY REFERENDUM

The Oak Hill Cemetery Association has expressed interest in dissolving/abandoning their duties/ownership and wanting the Village of North Freedom to take over operations/ownership of the Oak Hill Cemetery (located at 400 N Maple St, North Freedom, WI 53951). The Cemetery's annual expenses for 2025 were approximately \$32,000.00 (\$42,000.00 with accounting for cashed in assets (time deposits (aka: CDs))) with revenue only coming in at \$18,000.00 (\$28,000.00 with accounting for cashed in assets (time deposits (aka: CDs))), so they were operating at a \$14,000.00 deficit, approximately*. This has been an on-going trend for the Oak Hill Cemetery Association for many years now. The current Cemetery Board has stated that there is no one that would like to take it over and "work" for the Cemetery. If there are interested persons that would like to serve on their Board and take over operations, *PLEASE* let them know, <u>ASAP</u>! This may help prevent the needed referendum if the Village were to take over operations...

Why is a referendum needed? The Village of North Freedom's current levy is not sufficient enough to take on the additional financial obligation of operating a cemetery, therefore a referendum to increase the levy limit of the Village is being considered. Multiple referendum amounts are being weighed and the Village would like to invite the public (YOU!) to come and weigh these options together. There will be an informal public forum on Monday, January 12, 2026 – 6:00 PM to 6:30 PM in the North Freedom Community Center (105 N Maple St, North Freedom, WI 53951) where a presentation would be available for viewing and where the public can ask questions. No official Village Board action will take place during this forum. Following the forum will be the Village Caucus at 6:30 PM and then at 7:00 PM is the start of the Regular Board Meeting where the Village Board will act on a Resolution to take this subject to referendum. If a majority of the Village Board approves the Resolution, the electors of the Village will then vote on whether or not to approve the levy limit increase (amount still TBD) at the Spring Election on Tuesday, April 7, 2026. Please come and join the discussion! Maybe we can find a better solution together! •
