There will be NO parking on N Maple Street from the School through the 100 block of N Maple Street.

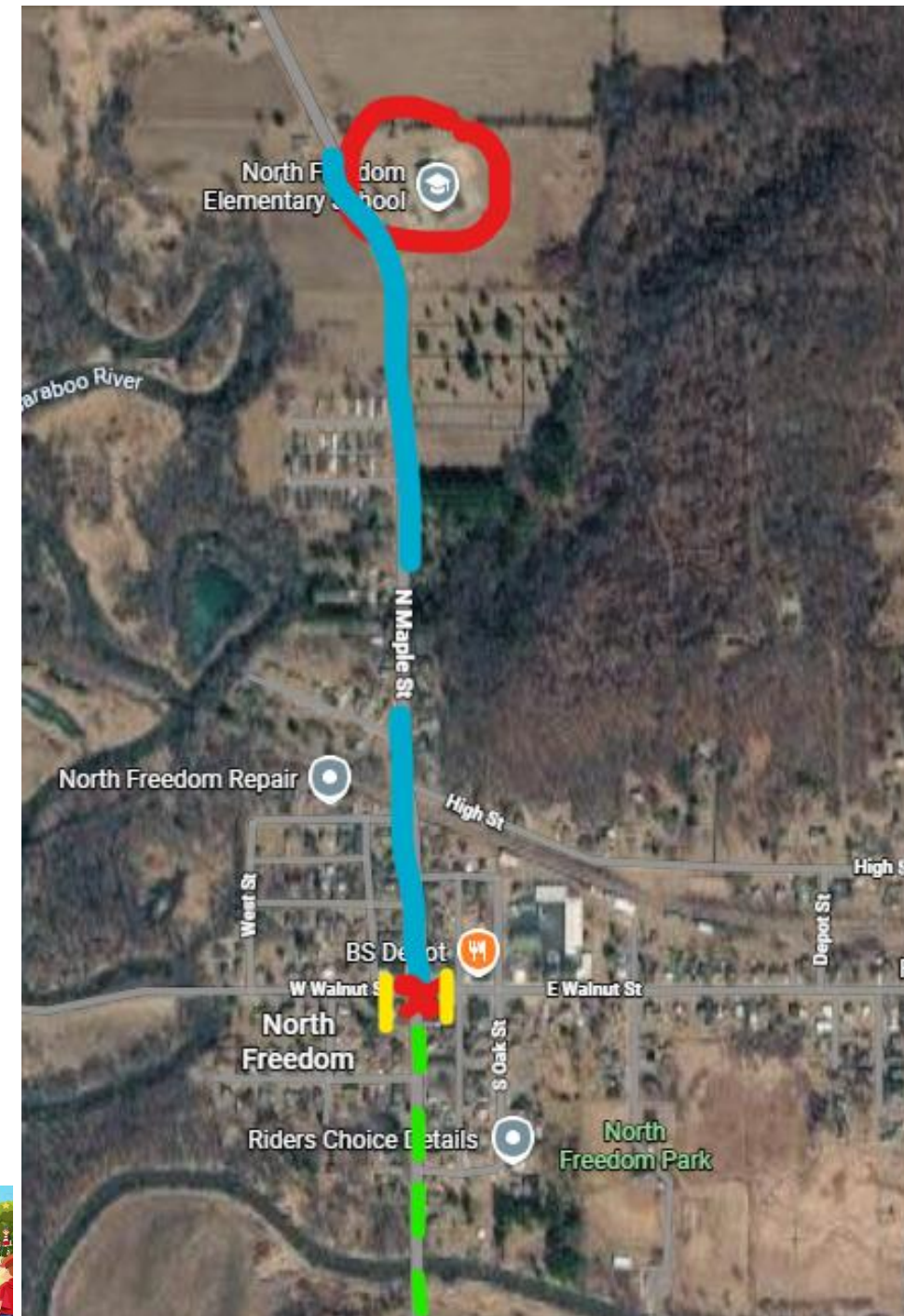
