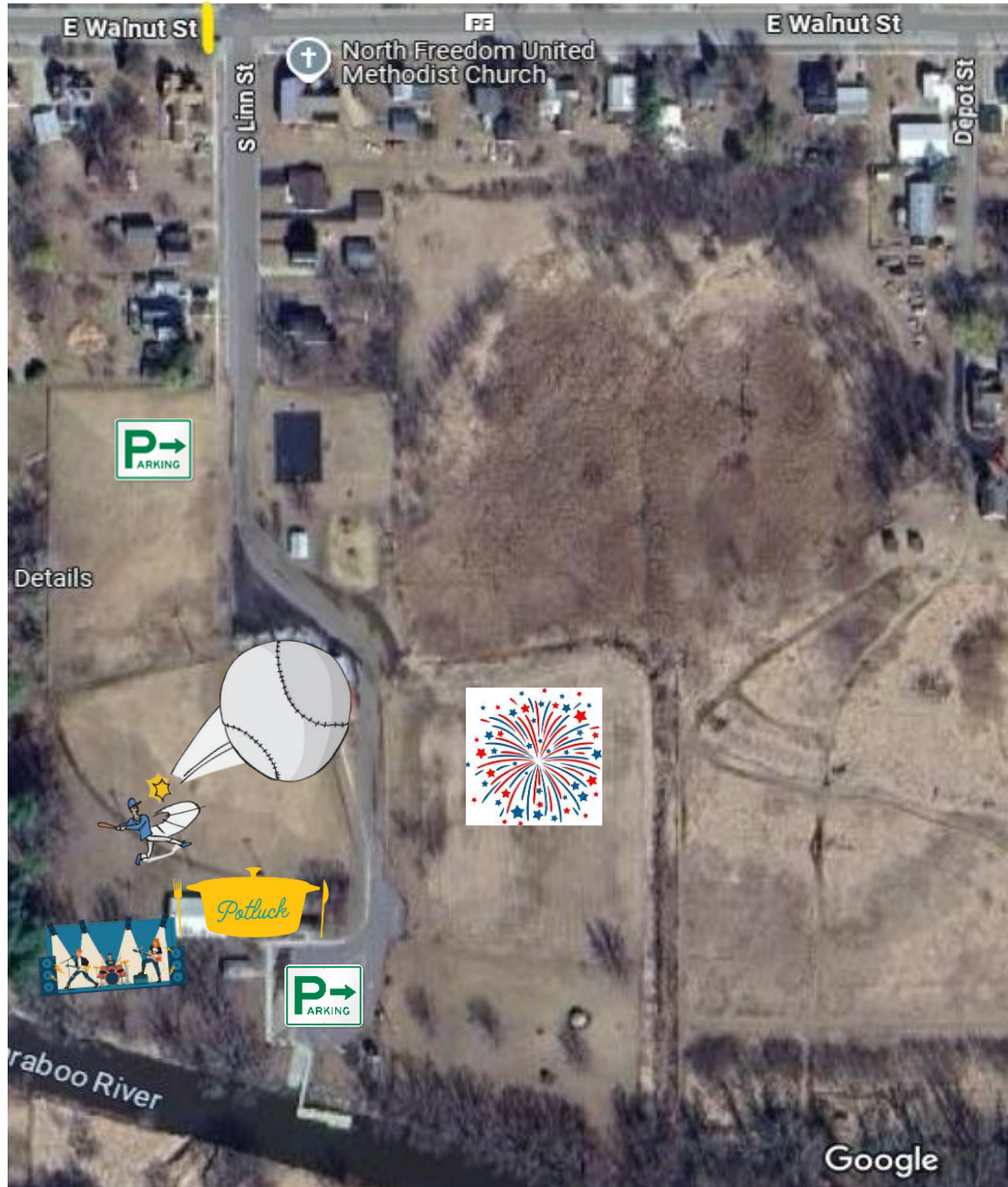

The park area will also have porta-potties available and ***limited*** parking. Due to congestion and the majority of the grass areas being in DNR protected wetlands, ***THERE WILL BE NO AVAILABLE PARKING EXCEPT IN THE DESIGNATED PARKING LOT BELOW BY THE BOAT LAUNCH OR IF IT IS NOT TOO WET, IN THE NORTHWESTERN FIELD! IF THE FIELD AREA IS WET, IT WILL BE ROPED OFF FOR NO PARKING. *****

There will be NO parking on N Maple Street from the School through the 100 block of N Maple Street.

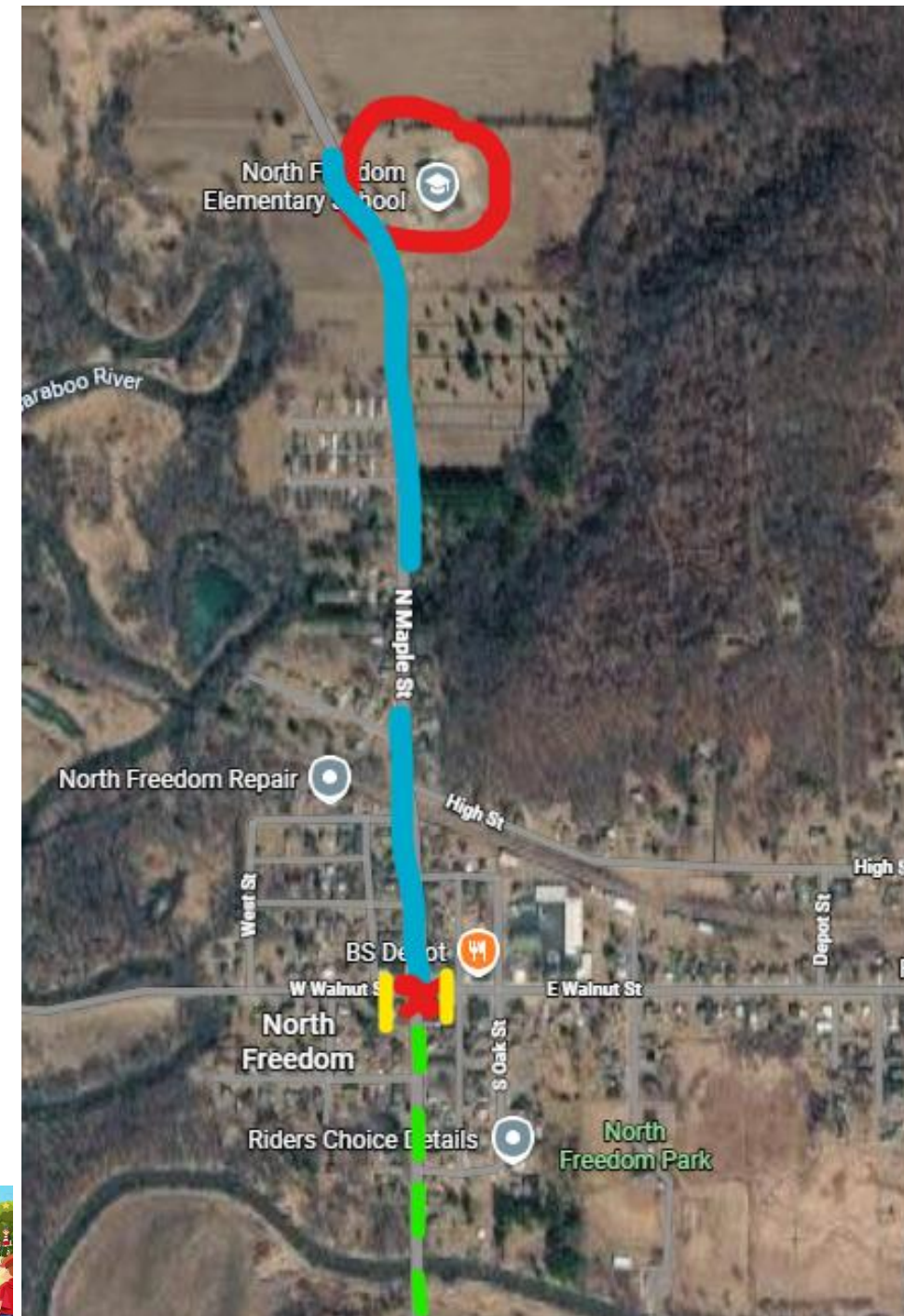
