

VILLAGE OF NORTH FREEDOM - ORDINANCE 2.04(1)

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FREEDOM,
WISCONSIN, SAUK COUNTY:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE:

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend and revise the Village of North Freedom Ordinances Chapter 2 titled "VILLAGE BOARD", Section 2.04 titled "COMMITTEES", Sub-Section (1) titled "STANDING COMMITTEES AND APPOINTMENTS".

SECTION 2: PROVISION TO BE AMENDED AND REVISED:

Village of North Freedom Ordinance 2.04(1) is amended and revised by this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: PROVISION AS AMENDED AND REVISED:

2.04 COMMITTEES. (1) STANDING COMMITTEES AND APPOINTMENTS.

At the first regular Board meeting following the spring election, the Village President shall, subject to confirmation by the Village Board, appoint 3 Trustees to each of the standing committees. The Village President shall designate committee chairmen. The standing committees are as follows:

- (a) Finance, Personnel, and Insurance Committee
- (b) Law & Ordinance, Zoning and Cable regulation Committee
- (c) Water and Sewer & Lagoon Maintenance Committee
- (d) Street & Sidewalk Maintenance Committee
- (e) Building Maintenance ~~and Rental Property~~ Committee
- (f) Park, Refuse and Recycling Committee
- ~~(g) Civic Improvements Committee~~

SECTION 4: VALIDITY:

Should any section, clause, or provision of the Ordinance be declared by the Courts to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 5: CONFLICTING PROVISIONS REPEALED:

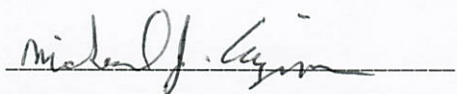
All Ordinances in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
