



Manual Roadside Services

- · Both trash and recycling will be collected weekly at the roadside.
- Please place all trash into containers or bags to ensure efficient and clean collection.
- Place all recyclables (see other side for acceptable items) in 32 gal container provided by GFL.
- Trash and recycling should be placed within 2 ft. of the roadside on one side of the driveway.

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

- Reduce paper waste by using both sides of the paper and using scrap paper whenever possible
- When shopping, reuse canvas, paper or plastic bags to bring home purchases



Mixed Containers

- Aluminum cans and clean aluminum foil
- Tin cans, steel cans and aerosol cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- #1, #2, and #5 type plastics
- Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons

Mixed Paper

- Newspaper, magazines, books, mail, school/ office paper
- Brown corrugated cardboard
- Gray chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes)
- Brown paper bags

DO NOT put the following items in the recycle container:



- Styrofoam of any kind
- Trash
- Construction material
- Clothing

- Yard waste
- · Household hazardous waste
- Electronics
- Shredded paper (loose or bagged)







COLLECTION INFORMATION

GFL Environmental Services will be the new solid waste & recycling service provider, effective January 1, 2022.

SERVICES

- · Both trash and recycling will be collected weekly at the roadside.
- Please place all trash into containers or bags to ensure efficient and clean collection.
- Place all recyclables (see other side for acceptable items) in 32 gal container provided by GFL. If all recycling does not fit into 32 gal container, you may place in other containers clearly marked for recycling or clear plastic bags. Local clean sweep programs may offer alternative options for disposal of fluorescent light bulbs, household hazardous waste, pharmaceuticals, and electronics.

CURBSIDE BULKY WASTE COLLECTION

- 1. Residents shall contact the GFL Customer Care Center to schedule the Bulky Waste Collection
- Resident will be asked to confirm address, and item for collection Limit of one item per week
- Resident will be provided with the day the collection will occur, along with a Work Order/Confirmation #

2. Items for collection include, but are not limited to the following:

- Household furniture (couches, chairs, tables, cabinets, dressers, or similar)
- Mattresses/Boxsprings
 Appliances
- · Carpet Roll (must be rolled and tied, not to exceed 4ft length or 12" diameter) max of six (6) rolls
- · Countertop, not to exceed 4ft length or 36" wide
- Doors, windows, toilet, other replacement items from a project
- · General debris that is too large to place in the cart
- Freon-appliances shall be charge \$50 per item
- · All items must be WI landfill-eligible for disposal

3. Excluded items include, but are not limited to the following:

• Freon Appliances • Electronic Waste • Tires • Any other items that are banned from WI landfills

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

1. Residents shall place Yard Waste in compostable bags, or containers that are clearly labeled as "YARD WASTE"

- Containers shall not exceed 32gal in size and weigh no more than 50# per container
- Branches shall be bundled/tied and placed with cut ends facing the street, as neatly as possible for driver safety and efficiency
- Branches shall be no longer than 4 feet, and diameter no more than 8 inches
