This Engineer Report is submitted in accordance with the requirements of 66.0703(10), 66.0703(5), Stats., and the direction given by the District Commission at the September 6, 2012 Summit Utility District No. 2 Meeting, determining to re-open special assessments levied on undeveloped/deferred benefited properties described in Schedule C of this Report for sanitary sewer improvements described in Schedule B of this Report.
