STREET SWEEPING SCHEDULED WEEK OF JUNE 20, 2022

The Village of Summit has contracted with Sweep-All to perform sweeping of various public streets and municipal lots with curb and gutter throughout the Village. This work is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 20th, 2022 and will continue through the week until completed. This work is weather dependent, and the schedule may change. A summary of those streets/public lots where sweeping services will be performed include:

- Silver Maple Ln
- Brightwater Subdivision (N Brightwater Blvd, N Waterstone Cir, N Ringtail Rd)
- Lake Country Village Subdivision (Dairy Blvd, Mineral Springs Blvd, Castle Rock Dr, Walleye Dr, Walleye Ct, Lake Country Blvd, Lake Country Dr, Winnebago Dr, Winnebago Ct, Mendota Dr, Mendota Ct, Fox River Ct, Kegonsa Dr)
- Interlaken Village Subdivision (Monona Ct)
- Still Waters Subdivision (Stillwater Dr, S Waters Edge Dr, Wood Side Dr, Wood Side Ct)
- Summit Village Hall
- I-94/CTH P Park N Ride

Village staff requests that vehicles be removed from the street and parked in driveways until sweeping has been completed to facilitate operations. Street sweeping helps keep streets cleaner, and it is an important part of stormwater pollution prevention. An additional round of sweeping will be performed in the autumn.
