Article 1:

To elect the following officers as required by law and to authorize the Board of School Directors to fix their compensation:

Article 2:

To hear and act on the reports of the Blue Mountain Union School District #21 officers for the past year.

Article 3:

Shall the voters of the Blue Mountain Union School District #21 authorize the Board of School Directors to borrow money by issuance of bonds or notes not in excess of anticipated revenues for the next fiscal year?

Article 4:

To transact any other business thought proper under this warning.

Said meeting shall be followed immediately by a public informational hearing regarding the proposed budget and other business, to be voted on by Australian Ballot, on Tuesday, March 3, 2026.

Wells River:	Village Garage in Wells River










On Tuesday, March 3, 2026 between 10:00 in the morning and 7:00 in the evening there will be a vote by Australian Ballot on the following question:

Article #1:


Shall the voters of the school district approve the school board to expend \$12,856,291.00 which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year? The Blue Mountain Union School District estimates that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in per pupil education spending of \$16,003.54 which is 20.05% higher than per pupil education spending for the current year.

The legal voters of the Blue Mountain Union School District #21 are further notified that voter qualification and registration relative to said Annual Meeting shall be as provided in Section 706u of Title 16 and Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.
