## Minocqua Police Activity Report January, 2017

#### Incidents:

During the month of January, 2017, the Minocqua Police Department handled 452 incidents with an additional 349 calls for service from the public which involved dispatching Woodruff Police Department, fire and EMS. The 452 incidents also include calls self-initiated by officers of the Department. This compares with 437 calls for service during January 2016; 375 calls for service during January, 2015; 384 calls for service during January, 2014; 304 calls for service during January 2013; 285 calls for service during January 2012; 398 calls for service during January, 2011; 456 calls for service during January 2010; and 426 calls for service during January 2009. A breakdown of those calls is as follows:
