## Minocqua Police Activity Report March, 2017

#### Incidents:

During the month of March, 2017, the Minocqua Police Department handled 517 incidents with an additional 411 calls for service from the public which involved dispatching Woodruff Police Department, fire and EMS. The 517 incidents also include calls self-initiated by officers of the Department. This compares with 421 calls for service during March 2016; 376 calls for service during March, 2015; 369 calls for service during March, 2014; 308 calls for service during March 2013; 307 calls for service during March 2012; 349 calls for service during March, 2011; 405 calls for service during March 2010; and 457 calls for service during March 2009. The Department currently has 25 open investigations since the implementation of the new records keeping system in May of 2011 which are actively being investigated at this time.

#### Other:

The Department has met with Woodruff Police Department Chief Lenny Drewsen about the boat patrol for the 2017 summer season. Part-time Woodruff Police Officer Gary Lade has agreed to conduct boat patrol for his third year for the 2017 summer season. It should be known that Officer Lade is pursuing fulltime employment with agencies around the area. If Officer Lade should get hired fulltime by another Department, this position will need to be filled.

March 6<sup>th</sup> the Chief met with Town Chairman Hartzheim, Town Clerk Haggart, K9 Handler Officer Matt Tate and Union Rep Randy Ingram (phone) to iron out the final touches of the K9 Handler Agreement.

March 6<sup>th</sup> the Department attended K9 Unit training to understand the capabilities and expectations of the Department when K9 Officer Jennings was on duty.
