Roadside Garbage Collection

- Pickup once per week in provided 95-gallon wheeled cart.
- Garbage must be placed roadside the night before, or prior to 6:00 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include: electronics, appliances, auto batteries and yard waste.
- All items must be placed in the cart in order to be collected.

Roadside Recycling Collection

- Pickup is once every four weeks.
- Recyclables must be placed roadside the night before, or prior to 6:00 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.

Accepted Materials:

- Plastic food, beverage, detergent bottles and jugs labeled #1 – #7
- Pill bottles
- Water bottles
- Glass bottles (green, brown and clear
- Glass jars (green, brown and clear
- Metal cans
- Aluminum cans
- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Telephone books

- Brown paper bags
- Corrugated cardboard (flattened out and cut in pieces 2' by 3' or smaller
- Office paper
- Copy paper
- Shredded paper in paper bag
- File folders
- File or packing boxes
- Junk mail
- Cereal boxes
- Brown or gray fiber packages (soda cartons, dry food packages, etc.)

Bulk Waste Collection

- Please contact Advanced Disposal to schedule a pick up at (800) 262-3101. There is a fee for this service.
- Bulk waste must be placed roadside the night before, or prior to 7 a.m. on the scheduled day of collection.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include: construction and demolition debris, tires, appliances or electronics.

Cart Placement

- Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from roadside.
- There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- Cart handle should be facing the house and away from the street.
