This ordinance supersedes Ordinance # 10 adopted September 5, 1973.

1. The Town Board of the Town of Remington does hereby ordain that before placing a trailer house, mobil home or bus in the Town of Remington to be used as a permanent or temperary residence, as determined by the Town Board, a permit at the cost of \$10.00 must be applied for from the Town Board.

Before any person shall locate a trailer house, mobil home or bus in the Town of Remington to be used as a permanent or temperary residence, as determined by the Town Board, they must give proof to the Town Board of water and sewer hook-up completion according to State and County requirements.

All trailer houses, mobil homes or buses must meet size requirement—original unit not less than 500 square feet.

All State licensed campgrounds are excempt from the above provisions.

- Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect after passage and publication.
