Ward One – the boundaries are the Town of Remington, part of Supervisor District #8, part of Pittsville School District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that for all voting purposes, the above ward will be as one, using one common polling place, which is named Town of Remington Town Hall and the address is Hwy 80, Babcock, Wi. The polling place, as required by law, is located in Ward One.
