An ORDINANCE AS TO LIVESTOCK

The Town Board of the Town of Remington, Wood County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follow:

Section 1. No barn, kennel, stable, yard, pasture or pen in which one or more carrel, horses mules or donkeys, sheep, swine, goats, rabbits, mink, fowl or poultry or other domestic animals, except dogs, are kept shall be hereafter located upon any private premises within one hundred fifty (150) feet of a dwelling other than that of the owner or keeper of such animals or adjacent to any property owned by the Town.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), together with the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.

SECTION: 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect after passage and publication.

This ordinance was Adopted on March 30th, 1970 and reviewed on November 14,2016, at The Regular Town Board Meeting, when it was concluded that the wording needed to be changed in ordinance #7 To read as above.
