SNOW ALERT INFORMATION:

- 7.0507 Parking During Snow Removal Alert Prohibited. It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle or motor vehicle upon any street within the City of Canistota after a snow removal alert has been declared.
 - A. <u>Definitions</u>. For the purposes of this Section, the following terms and words shall have the meaning given herein:
 - 1. <u>Snow Removal Alert</u>. Such times as there is a snow accumulation on the public streets of two inches or more, or such times as the Maintenance Supervisor or his or her designee declares that snow removal operations on the public streets will commence and that the provision of this Chapter in regard to parking on public streets during snow removal operations are effective and will be enforced.
 - 2. <u>Street</u>. The entire width of any public roadway within the City, and it shall not be limited to those roadways designated as a *Street* but shall include all other names by which public roadways are designated.
 - B. <u>Declaration of Snow Removal Alert</u>. When the Maintenance Supervisor or his or her designee determines that snow removal from the public streets will commence, the Maintenance Supervisor or his or her designee will announce through local news media and whatever other sources are available that there has been declared a snow removal alert and that the provisions of this Chapter will be effective and be enforced, designating a particular date and time when the alert shall commence. The determination to declare a snow removal alert will be based on the then existing weather conditions, and the amount of snow then on the ground or expected according to forecasts from the National Weather Service.
