CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

In accordance with Town of Woodruff Ordinance 249, the following rules apply to Evergreen Municipal Cemetery and Forest Garden Memorial Cemetery in Woodruff, Wisconsin.

1. No planting of flowers, shrubbery or trees is permitted on any cemetery lot.
2. Flowers may be placed in a wire box or basket on a stand small enough to be moved to facilitate mowing.
3. A permit must be obtained through the Town of Woodruff prior to any burial, or placement of any monument or marker.
4. Monuments/markers must be made of bronze, granite or marble.
5. Forest Garden Memorial Cemetery: Only flat monuments/markers are permitted.
6. All maintenance of grounds and graves will be completed by Town of Woodruff employees, including mowing, grading, tree trimming, and grass seeding, where required.
7. Annual Clean Up Week: The first week of April is designated as Cemetery Clean Up week. All artificial flowers, arrangements, and other grave decorations left on the graves will be removed and discarded during the clean up week.
