CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

In accordance with Town of Woodruff Ordinance 249, the following rules apply to Evergreen Municipal Cemetery and Forest Garden Memorial Cemetery in Woodruff, Wisconsin.

1. Individual graves may contain one full burial, one full burial and up to two cremation urns, or three cremation urns.
2. No person may deposit cremated remains in the cemetery without permission of the Sexton/Town.
3. No planting of flowers, shrubbery or trees is permitted on any cemetery lot.
4. Flowers may be placed in a wire box/basket on a stand small enough to be moved to facilitate mowing, or in a vase attached to the grave marker.
5. A permit must be obtained through the Town of Woodruff prior to any burial, or placement of any monument or marker.
6. Monuments/markers must be made of bronze, granite or marble.
7. Monuments/markers are owned by the Purchaser and not the property of the cemetery. Maintenance or repair of monuments is the responsibility of the Owner.
8. **Forest Garden Memorial Cemetery:** Only flat monuments/markers are permitted.

9. All maintenance of grounds and graves will be completed by Town of Woodruff employees/contractors, including mowing, grading, tree trimming, and grass seeding, where required.
10. Excavation of graves shall only be conducted by persons authorized by the Town Board.
11. Burials during winter season may be accommodated depending upon practicality due to weather and ground conditions. Individual estimates of cost will be provided upon request.
12. Cemetery roads will not be maintained for public traffic from November 1 through May 1
13. Annual Clean Up Week: Dependent upon weather conditions, one week in spring will be designated as Cemetery Clean Up week. Once identified, the clean-up week will be posted in Lakeland Times, on town website, and in town posting places. All artificial flowers, arrangements, and other grave decorations left on the graves will be removed and discarded during the clean-up week.
14. All dogs must be accompanied by their owner and be on a leash. Owners are required to clean up after their pet.
