Permit Rules

- Applicants for Transient Vendor Solicitation permits must register with the Ross Township Police Department located at 4055 Hamilton Cleves Road, Fairfield, Ohio, 45014. Prior to solicitation, transient vendors shall provide the information required thereon: a copy of the company's valid current vendor's license issued by Butler County, and the three (3) day cancellation form.
- 2) No fee shall be charged for registration, and registration shall be valid for a period of one (1) year.

- 3) No person, firm, or corporation shall conduct public solicitation in Ross Township, Butler County, Ohio, wherein the person conducting the solicitation does so in a manner whereby their conduct is contrary to the public interest. No solicitation tactics shall be employed which are coercive, abusive, or misleading. No efforts may be made by any person, firm, or corporation to defraud any individual through the solicitation process. Transient vendors shall comply with all applicable Federal and State Laws governing the conduct of their business, including the three (3) day cancellation provision, and the collection and payment of all applicable sales taxes, and upon making application, shall provide evidence of the same.
- 4) During the period from May 15th through August 15th door-to-door solicitation and solicitation from motor vehicles shall only be permitted between 9:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M.
- 5) During the period from August 16th through May 14th, door-to-door solicitation and solicitation from motor vehicles shall only be permitted between 9:00A.M. and 5:00 P.M.
- 6) Each transient vendor shall carry and display upon demand, their solicitation registration approval form at all times while selling on the street, or while travelling about the Township for the purpose of selling or soliciting orders.
- 7) Solicitation shall not occur on any residence where a no solicitation sign, decal, or other lawful display is exhibited.
