

RESOLUTION 2026-04
Designating a 365 Day Time Limit

WHEREAS, the Town Board for the Town of Wrightstown feels there is a need to establish a period of time that a utility permit would be application when issued for work in the Town of Wrightstown; and,

WHEREAS, the Zoning Administrator has reviewed with the Planning Commission for the Town of Wrightstown the need for a time limit for any utility permit issued and also compared the time limits set by surrounding municipalities. The Planning Commission is recommending the establishment of a utility permit that would run for 365 days from the date it is issued by the Zoning Administrator.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Wrightstown, Brown County, Wisconsin, by this Resolution, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present, and voting and proper notice having been given; resolved and approves that any utility permits that are issued by the Zoning Administrator for the Town of Wrightstown would be valid for 365 from the date it is issued.
