Resolution 2026-05 Adopting the Brown County, Wisconsin, 2026 All Hazards Mitigation Plan

Whereas, the Town Board for the Town of Wrightstown recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town of Wrightstown; and,

Whereas, the Town Board for the Town of Wrightstown has reviewed a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Brown County 2026 All Hazards Mitigation Plan, that is in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

Whereas, Resolution 2026-05 Adopting the Brown County, Wisconsin, 2026 All Hazards Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Town of Wrightstown from impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

Whereas, adoption by the Town Board of the Town of Wrightstown demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2026 All Hazards Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN BOARD FOR THE TOWN OF WRIGHTSTOWN, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with the Town Board for the Town of Wrightstown policy for adopting Resolutions, the Town of Wrightstown adopts the Brown County, Wisconsin, 2026 All Hazards Mitigation Plan. While content related to the Town of Wrightstown may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the Town of Wrightstown to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate resolution adoptions.
