RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TOWN CLERK-TREASURER TO DESIGNATE ELECTION INSPECTORS NUMBER, SHIFTS & ALTERNATES ON ELECTION DAY

BY, the provisions of the State of Wisconsin Statutes, and the Election Administration Manual for the County and Municipal Clerks the following regulations are to be administered by the Town Clerk-Treasurer;

BY, the provisions of the State of Wisconsin Statutes, each polling place should have five inspectors. The governing body of the municipality may reduce the number of election inspectors by resolution. They may also provide for the selection of alternates or for the selection of two sets of inspectors to work at different times (split shifts) on election day. The alternates may be used to allow inspectors to leave the place for meal breaks. No polling place may have fewer than three election inspectors at any time.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Maple Grove Town Board Members hereby authorize the Town Clerk-Treasurer to determine the number of Election Inspectors to work each election, in either numbers of three or five depending on the number of ballots and anticipated voter turnout. The Clerk-Treasurer may authorize split election inspector shift when it is necessary. In addition, authorization of the Clerk-Treasurer or an alternate from the bi-annually approved election inspector list to cover the polls for each inspector for meal breaks. It is also the Clerk-Treasurer duty to provide the election inspectors with training, or have them attend training classes and to administer the oath of office to all inspectors every two years.

WHEREAS, the Town of Maple Grove Resolution 2025-7 was introduced and adoption moved by Town Board Member Laabs and seconded by Tisler. Upon a voice vote, the results are as follows
