

TOWN OF MAPLE GROVE
RECYCLING & WASTE DISPOSAL RULES

Recyclable - Drop-Off Site:

Location: 19435 Marquette Road, Reedsville, WI

Hours: 1st & 3rd Saturday, 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM

Recyclables are now collected together at the drop-off site and goes into the recycling dumpster in the Recycling Center Building.

Do not place collected recyclables in plastic bags or bundled together. All recyclables must be clean except those listed below

- 1) Aerosol containers go into garbage compactor
- 2) Aluminum cans shall be separated from other recyclables and put into the aluminum cans container.
- 3) Bi-metal, Tin, and Steel containers shall be separate from other recyclables and put into the metal dumpster.

Per Recycling Ordinance 1.19 Enforcement: Penalties for violating this ordinance may be assessed as follows:

- (a) Any person who violates s. 1.18 may be required to forfeit \$50 for a first violation, \$200 for a second violation, and not more than \$2000 for a third or subsequent violation.
- (b) Any person who violates a provision of this ordinance, except s. 1.18, may be required to forfeit not less than \$10 or more than \$1000 for each violation.

Waste Disposal - Drop off Site:

1. **Ashes:** Ashes cannot be dumped from November 1 to March 1.
2. **Garbage:** All garbage must be placed in CLEAR plastic bags. There will be a charge assessed by the attendant for all materials for the dumpster that is not in the required bags.

Fees are as follows: \$3.00 per clear bag;
\$6.00 per barrel;
\$20.00 for small pick-up loads or trailers and;
\$30.00 for large pick-up loads or wagons

Individual Responsibility ** Cost to be paid by the individual.

1. **Car Batteries:** Batteries can be taken to:

2. **Computers:** Contact the Manitowoc County Materials Recovery Facility at 683-4333 for dates and times. Computer components are as follows: CPUs, monitors, printers, keyboards, laptops, modems, mouse, storage drives, terminals, and mainframes.
3. **Large Items:** All large items such as air conditioners, boilers, carpet, clothes dryers, clothes washers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, drywall, fiberglass insulation, freezers, furniture, furnaces, humidifiers, mattresses, ovens, refrigerators, shingles, siding (vinyl), stoves, televisions, toilet bowls, water heaters and water softeners must be taken by private or commercial haulers.
4. **Tires:** Call the Manitowoc County Materials Recovery Facility at 683-4333 for dates and times of collection.
5. **Clean Sweep:** Household hazardous chemicals are collected annually. Call the Manitowoc County Materials Recovery Facility at 683-4333 for dates and times of collection. Chemicals typically collected are: pesticides, non-latex paints, varnishes, shellacs, thinners, oven cleaners, polishes, spot removers, waste oil, and antifreeze.

Individual Responsibility

1. **Yard Waste:** Under the law, yard waste from either residential or commercial sources is **banned from all landfills**. Yard waste consists of grass clippings, leaves, yard and garden debris and brush, including clean, woody vegetative materials no greater than six inches (6”) in diameter. Yard waste does not include: stumps, roots, or shrub with intact root balls. **We urge all citizens to reduce and reuse yard waste.**

ATTENTION LANDLORDS: Please inform all tenants of these rules. If additional Recycling and Waste Disposal Rules sheets are needed, contact the Town Clerk-Treasurer or the attendants at the Drop-off Site.

- Manitowoc County Material Recovery Facility is located at 3000 Basswood Road, Manitowoc and their hours are: Mon-Fri, 8:00 AM - 4:30 PM and Sat, 8:00 AM - 12:00 Noon
