A Resolution Adopting the National Incident Management System (NIMS)

WHEREAS, Homeland Security Presidential Directive-5 directs the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to develop and administer the National Incident Management System (NIMS), providing a consistent nationwide approach for all levels of government to work together effectively during domestic incidents; and

WHEREAS, NIMS establishes standardized incident management processes, including the Incident Command System (ICS), unified command, resource management, training, and interoperable communications; and

WHEREAS, adoption of NIMS is required for eligibility for certain federal preparedness grants and enhances the jurisdiction's ability to prevent, prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, failure to adopt NIMS may preclude reimbursement for emergency response and recovery costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Maple Grove hereby adopts the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as its standard for incident management and coordination;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all departments, agencies, and personnel of Town of Maple Grove shall utilize NIMS principles, including ICS, in all emergency and disaster operations;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Town of Maple Grove will provide appropriate NIMS and ICS training to personnel with emergency management responsibilities.
