

**RESOLUTION 2026-4**

**Adopting the Manitowoc County Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan 2025-2030**

The Town Board of the Town of Maple Grove, duly assembled, resolves as follows:

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Maple Grove recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted multi-hazards mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Maple Grove participated jointly in the planning process with Manitowoc County and the other local units of government within the County to prepare a Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Maple Grove, hereby adopts the Manitowoc County Multi-Hazards Mitigation Plan 2025-2030 as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Town of Maple Grove Town Board will provide a copy of this signed resolution to the Manitowoc County Emergency Management Department.
