

## Are you registered?

You must be registered to vote in order to request an absentee ballot or vote in person on election day. If you have not registered yet you can do one of the following:

- 1. Register online at <a href="www.myvote.wi.gov">www.myvote.wi.gov</a> by 11:59pm the 20<sup>th</sup> day before election day (3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday before). Registering online requires that you already have a valid, unexpired Wisconsin driver's license or Wisconsin state ID card. The address, name, date of birth, and driver license number you are using to register to vote must match the information that DMV has on file for you. If you need to update your address with DMV, you can do so online at <a href="https://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/dmv/license-drvs/rnew-and-chge/change-address.aspx">https://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/dmv/license-drvs/rnew-and-chge/change-address.aspx</a>.
- 2. Fill out a voter registration form and provide a copy of your proof of residence from the list attached and return it to your Clerk's office.
- 3. The last day to register to vote in the Clerk's office prior to an election is the Thursday before from 8:00am 4:30pm.
- 4. Same day registration at the polling location on the day of the election. To save time, fill out the voter registration form ahead of time and remember to bring your proof of residence.
