What is Not Accepted:

- Pharmaceuticals, IVs, needles
- Explosives, detonators, blasting caps
- Radioactive materials including smoke alarms
- Infectious and biological waste
- Compressed gas cylinders
- · Recyclables, yard and household waste
- Asbestos
- Demolition materials

Resource Solutions will accept the following items at Clean Sweep:

No charge: computers and accessories, power strips, calculators, copiers, scanners, printers, telephones, cell phones, fax machines, VCR/DVD players, stereo equipment, remote controls, rechargeable batteries from laptops, power tools, car batteries, scrap metal, grills, fans, electric motors, pots and pans, snow blowers.

\$15 - Microwaves

\$20 - Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, dorm size refrigerators, lawn mowers (oil drained, tires removed), TVs - up to 29", CRT monitors, flat screen computer monitors (LCD)

\$25 - Stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, furnaces

\$35 - Large Freon appliances

\$40 - TVs - 30"-49"

\$60 - TVs - 50" and up, projection, wooden console
